



**An Articulation Agreement
Between
Jarvis Christian College and Jacksonville College
for**

Associate of Arts and Associate of Sciences to Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science

Introduction

Jarvis Christian College (JCC) wishes to partner with transfer institutions interested in ensuring students take the maximum courses possible prior to transfer with college-level courses earned counting toward their intended field of study or major. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) formally recognizes that Jarvis Christian College and Jacksonville College are active educational partners, committed to providing greater educational opportunities and services for students transferring between institutions, in support of the concept of seamless transfer so that transfer students are not required to repeat courses already successfully completed.

Jarvis Christian College is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools – Commission on Colleges (SACS-COG), Jacksonville College, located in Jacksonville, TX, is also accredited by SACS-COG.

Each institution, furthermore, is dedicated to serving students from all walks of life, regardless of race, color, sex, pregnancy, religion, creed, national origin (including ancestry), citizenship status, physical or mental disability, age, marital status, and veteran status (including special disabled veteran, Vietnam-era veteran, or recently separated veteran), predisposing genetic characteristics, domestic violence victim status, low income, limited English language proficiency or any other protected category under applicable local, state or federal law, as well as persons who have opposed discrimination or participated in any complaint process on campus or before a government agency.

Purpose

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to formalize a partnership to assist students to achieve both associate and baccalaureate completion. This agreement enables students attending who transfer to Jarvis Christian College to have the college-level credits earned apply toward their intended field of study or major, resulting in degree completion and successful employment. In order to establish and improve the transfer process for our mutual students, we agree to the terms and conditions below:

Terms and Conditions:

1. The Articulation Agreement shall remain effective for three years or until one (1) or both; institutions deem it necessary to amend or terminate it. The desire to amend or terminate the Agreement must be submitted in writing to the President of the partnering institution.

2. JCC and Jacksonville College will jointly develop online transfer planning guides. By creating these online guides, JCC and Jacksonville College assures students that courses listed in these guides are freely transferable between JCC and Jacksonville College. JCC will post these transfer planning guides on the JCC Website.
3. Jacksonville College students who follow the recommended transfer guide and who meet all other admission requirements shall be eligible for admission to JCC. Transfer students must meet the same standards and criteria for admission to a major as native JCC students.
4. JCC will encourage Jacksonville College transfer students to complete the appropriate Associate Degree either before matriculation to JCC or by reverse transfer of course credit following admission to and attendance at JCC.
5. JCC agrees to provide transfer students with information regarding the availability of transfer scholarships for eligible students as well as other financial aid opportunities at JCC.
6. Representatives from JCC and Jacksonville College will meet or make contact at least once per year to exchange course catalogs and discuss current transfer admission information to be used during the subsequent academic year.
7. Jacksonville College will publicize and help facilitate campus visits by JCC recruiters and will prominently display JCC posters and literature and provide suitable space for a JCC recruiter to advise students on the Jacksonville College campus.
8. Jacksonville College will advise students who select JCC as their choice of transfer college in accordance with the online transfer guides developed collaboratively between Jacksonville College and JCC faculty. Adherence to the transfer guides facilitates transfer, allowing Jacksonville College students to maximize eligibility for in-state tuition and federal financial aid.
9. The Articulation Agreement shall be filed with the Offices of the Chief Executive Officers and Provosts at both institutions as well as with the Admissions and Registrar's Offices at each institution.
